The following is required: 45 semester hours, cumulative GPA 2.75, passed MoGEA on each section and attained a 'B' in COM 115, completed SEC 302 with a 'C', passed first portfolio check, background check on file.

The student must: be admitted to Teacher Education program, cumulative 2.75 GPA, completed at least 15 hours at Missouri State University, 3.0 GPA in major, passed second portfolio check, Family care and safety registry, TB test, Professional Liability Insurance, FBI clearance, and recommendations by student's advisor, Teacher Education and the Art and Design Department.

#### Requirements for Certification

To be recommended a student must have: completed supervised teaching, met all Missouri teacher certification requirements, met the criteria established by Missouri State Board of Education exit evaluation procedures, completed professional education courses with a 3.0 GPA (no grade below a 'B'), cumulative 2.75 GPA, passed final portfolio check.

To be admitted to the Teacher Education program you must have completed COM 115, EDC 150 and SEC 302 with a "C" or higher, have a combined GPA of 2.75 or higher, and have passed all the components of the **MoGEA** assessments, completed portfolio checkpoint 1 and background check.

Prerequisites to meet before you can enroll in **SEC 302** —45 hours completed, combined GPA 2.75 or higher, and EDC 150 or concurrent enrollment or equivalent competencies.

Ask your advisor to be admitted to Degree Program when you have 30 or more hours completed, a combined GPA of 3.0 or higher, and have ART 100, 101, 115, 215 in progress.

Admission to degree program is different from Admission to Teacher Education program. See your advisor in order to file your Degree Program Application.
